- Grass Cutting;** Cllr CD gave an up to date report that he was getting 3 quotes, he will meet with the contractors and walk the village with them to show them what needs doing. **RESOLVED.**
- Highways and footpaths;** Cllr DR reported that the granite sets at Northlands Road have become loose. Also the road markings in the village, to slow the traffic, have worn away. The Council had a discussion regarding the junction at the entrance to the village off of the A..... There has been 3 accidents in the last 2 months, the latest this evening. **RESOLVED** that the Chairman will draft a letter to BCC, (TfB), to inform them of the situation. It was felt by all the Councillors that the speed limit was to high, on the bends, being 60 mph.

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- c. **Cycleway**; Cllr SW reported that a small tree needs to be removed, when the cycleway reaches the Adstock junction. Cllr CD asked Cllr Llew Monger, where the money has come from to produce a cycleway? Funding has come from the Government for sustainable travel in rural areas.
- d. **Play area**; RESOLVED that Cllr SW & Cllr DR will check through the playground inspection and give a report of what is needed.

- a. **16/02634/APP** Land at West Street Adstock Erection of 6 no. stables and a tack room

Cllr SW reported that after the last meeting he had spoken to the land owners regarding the applications 16/0263 & 16/02274. the Councillors had agreed to send in no objections for these 2 applications. **RESOLVED**
 - c. **16/03094/APP** The Old Rectory Church End MK18 2HY Erection of a granny annex on site of existing tennis court within the garden area and extension of existing internal gravel driveway to service. Cllr PS sat back from the conversation. Cllr SW said that as the PC hadn't objected to the original planning application and this one is decidedly smaller, there wasn't sufficient reasons for a different comment. He proposed No objections. **RESOLVED**
- Village Plan Working Group**; CD reported that the date to go 'live' is 18th October, with an open evening to explain to residents what the group is hoping to achieve. The questionnaire would go out to all the residents to be collected by the 4th November.
