- 17/03303/AOP** | Outline application with all matters reserved for the erection of three dwellings and a storage barn with one dwelling above. | Adstock Manor Main Street Adstock Buckinghamshire MK18 2HT. Members **RESOLVED** to oppose this application for the reasons;
 - The proposed access/exit is not viable, it will be detrimental to the amenities of the neighbours
 - It is on a dangerous corner
 - It is too close to existing properties
 - The proposed access was originally the drive to the Manor; it was not the access to the Stud Farm which has not been in existence for 20 plus years.
 - Scotts Lane is not a viable alternative access.
- Neighbourhood Working Group;** Cllr Dawe proposed that the next stage is to take the key sections, set up sub committees of 3 - 5 people possibly chaired by a parish councillor, with the remit to
